

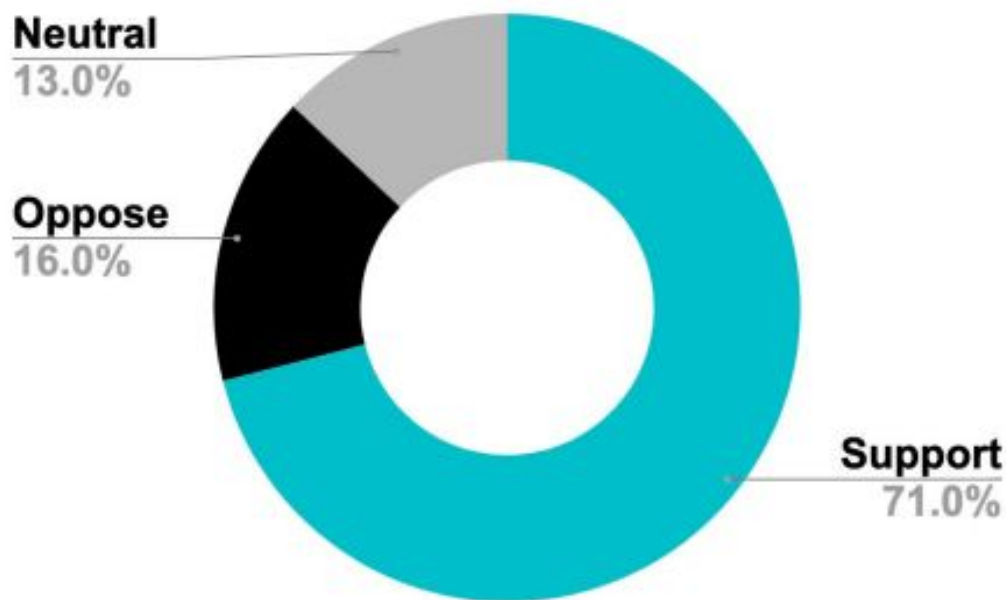

POLLING ALASKANS ON A
CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT TO
ALLOW FOR REASONABLE LIMITS ON
POLITICAL SPENDING



Would you support or oppose a constitutional amendment that allowed for reasonable limits on political spending?

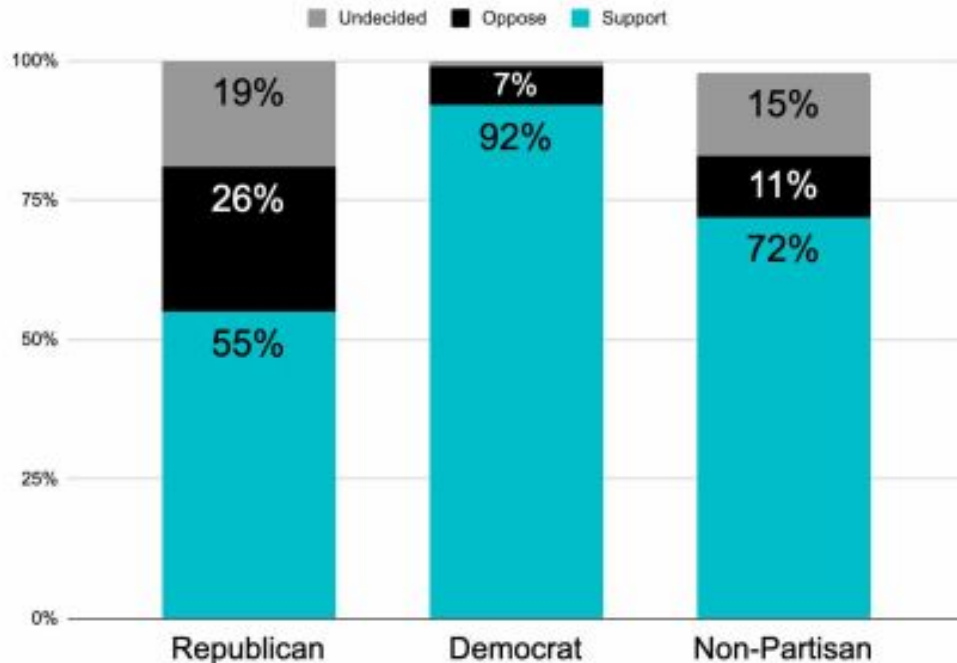


With a strong majority of Alaskans (71%) saying they support the amendment, it garners more than 4x as many Alaskan voters supporters than opponents (16%).



Amendment earns majority support across parties,

Though Democrats and non-partisans are much more likely to support it.



An overwhelming 92% of Democrats support the proposed constitutional amendment. More than half of Republicans support the amendment, while around ¼ oppose it.



Reasonable limits on campaign contributions would give less power to out of state interests and more power to Alaskans in our elections. Does this information make you more or less likely to support the amendment that would enable Americans to enact reasonable limits on campaign contributions and undisclosed political spending?
